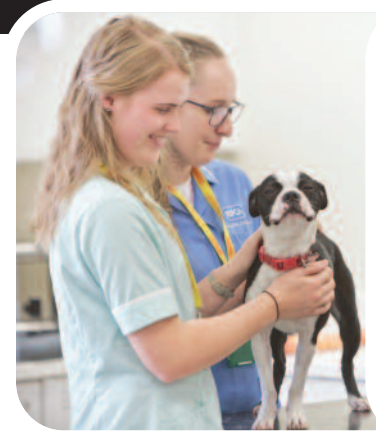

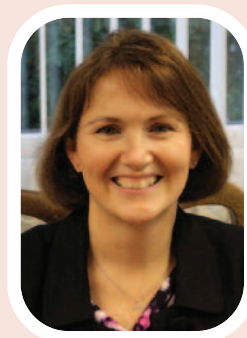

Subject area talks

Following the welcome talk there will be a series of subject talks, information sessions and tours from each of our curriculum areas. The teaching staff will be able to talk through the various modules that make up each course, explain the differences between the levels of each degree and tell you more about the entry requirements, practical activities and typical career opportunities in that area. These start at 11am in the following rooms:

- HE9 Motorsport and Agricultural Machinery Engineering
